Assessing and Treating Tendon Pain - Shaun Brewster

The way we have assessed and treated tendon related pain has changed in recent years. No longer are passive interventions, topical or invasive methods indicated. A wealth of research and clinical evidence now points to a simpler load-based management protocol. This presentation will provide strategies for pain management and rehabilitation for those suffering from tendon pathologies.



Cholesterol: Ayurvedic Diet and Lifestyle and some Herbal Remedies - Neerja Ahuja

Cholesterol is a fatty acid that is a part of circulating lipids in the body and is needed to build cell membranes, vitamin D, hormones, and much more. It is both derived from the diet and synthesises within the body, mainly in the liver. From the ayurvedic perspective, the body also needs cholesterol for supporting and lubricating the body's channels, known as srotas. In this session, we will look at what are some diet, lifestyle and herbal recommendations from Ayurveda for managing cholesterol.



Nutrition Interventions in Persistent Pain - Ananda Mahony

Chronic pain is associated with increased risks of co-morbid health conditions, increased body mass and poorer diet quality and patterns. Dietary interventions can have significant effects on pain reduction and overall quality of life. In this talk Ananda will draw on recent research to discuss how dietary intake can directly impact persistent pain, support weight loss, and reduce the risk of co-morbid conditions. Ananda will examine specific dietary approaches and discuss a number of case examples.



What is Integrative Oncology: What does it look like to work as a team in an integrative oncology space? - Victoria Choi

Integrative Oncology is a growing space in Australia, however currently there is limited integration with conventional cancer treatments. My work as a clinician and researcher at the Chris O'Brien Lifehouse in Sydney presents a potential example of what it might look like for the future of cancer care in Australia, if there is better integration of complementary medicine and conventional medicine.
